In June, our first summer hostile training will be in Lebanon. A rapid, armed training. 3 days completely on the shooting range and 1 day melee, bare-handed, armed, knife-disarming-fight techniques, force on force training.

In addition to Lebanese instructors, Lebanese special forces trainers will conduct further training the team.

There will be no techniques learned, heard from others, but solutions and drills that have been tested in real life and are based on real experience. Lebanese have been fighting since birth, and participants will see this.

After a long, tiring day of training, the team will get to know the Lebanese culture and our hosts will take care of it. Food, lifestyle, cheerfulness are just as much a part of everyday life as weapons.

What we ask for:

- Registration form completed and signed (attached below)
- Copy of Passport
- CV
- Clean Criminal Record
- Payment of a deposit (€ 500) and proof of payment

After submitting the registration form and sending it, we will provide you with the ESA Middle East account number. EUR account inside EU. As places are limited due to the nature and location of the training, there is an order of arrival, the place is provided by the person who arranges the documentation and payment of the deposit earlier. Participants will receive an accredited diploma, a reference from a Lebanese security company for high-performance providers. This is a really unique chance. Training and work related reference letter.

- UBAC shirt (black or multicam)
- Eye protection (tactical sunglasses / ballistic glasses)
- Hearing protection.
- Baseball cap (black or multicam)
- Tactical belt
- Civilian clothing (In the city we do not use military clothing)

If do you have your own gear like plate carriers, tactical belts etc, you can bring them, However, if it is military grade equipment like armour plates, helmets etc these will need to be removed from the vest and left at home, we can then replace the plates when we are in country.
